Advice for schools for Term 3

Schools will be open to welcome students back to onsite learning from the beginning of Term 3 on Tuesday 21 July.

The NSW Government closed the border with Victoria from 12:01am on Wednesday 8 July 2020. All staff and students returning from Victoria after this time must have a permit to enter NSW and are required to self-isolate for a period of 14 days.

All students who have been in Victoria in the last 14 days before the commencement of school must not attend school until they complete the 14 days self-isolation period since they left Victoria.

NSW Health has requested anyone who has been in Victoria and is unwell or has flu-like symptoms arrange to be tested through their local medical practitioner or one of the COVID-19 clinics.

COVID 19 UPDATE

Schools continue to adapt to the changing circumstances Covid 19 presents. Department of Education (DoE) procedures and activities allowed from Term 3 include:

- Inter-school student events, with no parent/carer attendance
- Internal school events/programs involving external providers, such as Story Bus, etc
- P & C meetings, with a strong preference for on-line communication
- Parent-teacher meetings, with a strong preference for on-line meetings

Activities that continue to be under review include:

- Kindergarten orientation
- Parent attendance at assemblies and other school events (e.g. graduation ceremonies)
- Parent volunteers e.g. parent reading helpers (note: canteen and uniform shop volunteers are permitted)
- School-based activities that involve large gathering of adults are not permitted at this time. These include parent/community gatherings such as parent functions, working bees, fundraisers, school BBQs, parent information evenings, and on-site cultural events.
